The Municipal Police Training Committee, in cooperation with Massachusetts Community Colleges, proudly presents a new career training opportunity for those who strive to become municipal police officers in the Commonwealth. After several years of development, the Municipal Police Training Committee will offer the first Basic Curriculum Academy specifically developed for people who have already completed the Law Enforcement Certificate Program or who have a post secondary degree in Criminal Justice. The first class for this new, fifteen week training program will begin on July 30, 2007 at the Boylston Regional Police Academy. To be eligible for this program, candidates must be hired by a municipal police department or be sponsored by a municipal police department. The rigorous training program will use the knowledge gained in a post secondary criminal justice program as a foundation to develop the skills and abilities necessary to be an entry level police officer in Massachusetts. **Candidates must pass the Municipal Police Training Committee's LECP Comprehensive Exam.
