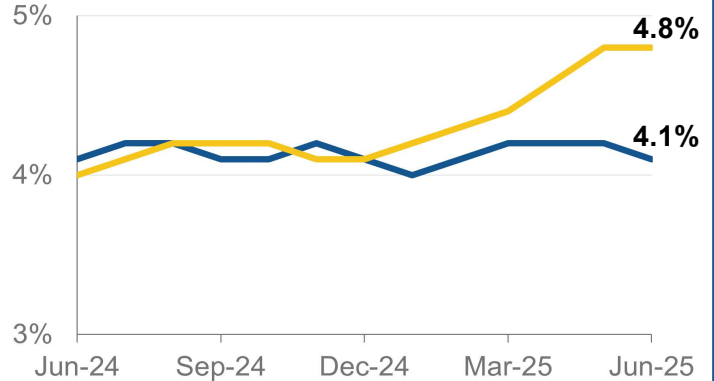

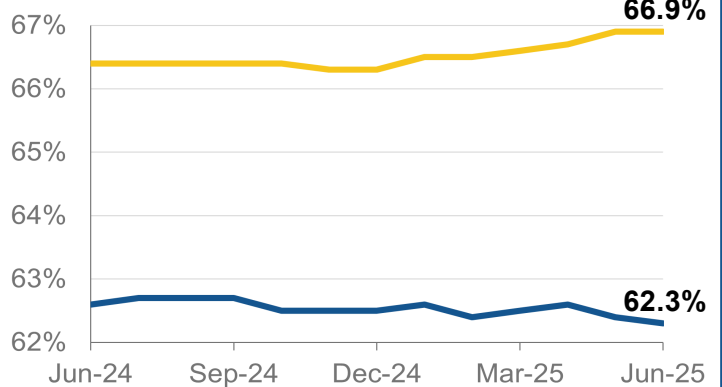
### Unemployment Rate
