NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on July 12, 2011, the Commission finds American-Lithuanian Naturalization Club dba Athol Mass Inc. in violation of M.G.L. c.94 §186 (1 count).

The Commission suspends the licensee's license for a total of two (2) days to be served. The suspension shall commence on **Wednesday, September 28, 2011** and terminate on **Friday, September 30, 2011**. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, September 28, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Saturday, October 1, 2011.


You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

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DECISION

American-Lithuanian Naturalization Club dba Athol Mass Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 12, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.94, §186 (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Dennis Keefe's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
2. Investigator Dennis Keefe's Report dated April 7, 2011; and
3. One (1) bottle of Yukon Jack Whiskey.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

FACTS


1. On Thursday April 7, 2011, Investigators entered the licensed premise to determine the manner in which the business was conducted.
2. The investigators did an inspection of the bar area and observed a bottle of Yukon Jack Liqueur (1 liter), containing a foreign matter, specifically fruit flies and other foreign material.
3. Administrative review of the file indicates a Commission violation by the licensee in 1998.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.94, §186 (1 count) and therefore **suspends the license for two (2) days.**
