I am a 28 year old MA resident, a casual DFS player, playing in the occasional NHL contest.

I am in favor of the majority of the proposed regulations, except for two of them.

I think that 21 is not the correct age to limit minors, 18 is a more appropriate age. It is unfair and illogical to prevent people 18-20 from playing in DFS contests, while they are allowed to buy in to the state-sponsored gambling by buying lottery tickets and scratch tickets.

I also disagree with preventing companies from running DFS contests based around college sports. In theory I agree, but student athletes are already being exploited by other industries, so it is unfair and illogical to prevent the DFS industry from doing the same. I would be in favor of any regulation that would protect student athletes from all commercial exploitation, but that is obviously not a measure that would get any support from the public or industry.
