An Initiative Petition for a Constitutional Amendment Relative to the Massachusetts National Guard

Amendment Article LIV of the Massachusetts Constitution is hereby amended by adding the following thereto:

‘Provided, that the said governor shall not, at any time hereafter, by virtue of any power by this constitution granted, or hereafter to be granted to him by the legislature, transport any of the inhabitants of this commonwealth, or oblige them to march out of the limits of the same; except so far as may be necessary to march or transport them by land or water or air, for the defence of such part of the state, to which they cannot otherwise conveniently have access or to provide emergency temporary assistance to other states during times of natural disaster within the territory of the United States.’

This Amendment shall take effect no later than December 31, 2016.
