LT. COL. GAYLE CAMERON CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Served in New Jersey State Police for 28 years, beginning as a Road Duty Trooper in 1980 and rising through the ranks to Lieutenant Colonel, Deputy Superintendent of Investigations before retiring in 2008.
- As a Detective for nine years, Cameron conducted numerous criminal investigations of individuals and organized groups, including undercover work within casino resorts.
- In her role as Deputy Superintendent, Cameron supervised all statewide investigations including the Casino Gaming Bureau. New Jersey State Police casino investigations average 1500 investigations and 800 arrests per year. This includes money laundering, fraud, and enterprise crimes.
- Appointed as a Commissioner to the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA), Cameron was responsible for policy decisions around the creation of appropriate law enforcement standards. She worked to strengthen crime prevention, solidify interagency cooperation, and improve community confidence in the agency.
- Cameron is a founding member and past president of New Jersey Woman in Law Enforcement (NJWLE) from 2004-2011.
- Served as a presenter and panelist for National and State Training Conferences.
- Cameron mentored an inner city child with Big Brothers/Big Sisters from 1999-2008.
- Cameron holds a Bachelor's Degree in Health and Physical Education from Bridgewater State College and a Master's Degree in Education from Seton Hall University.
