

PET FOOD RECALL

Nutro Products has announced a voluntary recall of select varieties of **Nutro Natural Choice Complete Care** dry cat foods and **Nutro Max** dry cat foods with “Best if used by Dates” between May 12, 2010 and August 22, 2010. The cat food is being voluntarily recalled in the United States and ten additional countries. This recall is due to incorrect levels of zinc and potassium. Both of which are essential nutritional supplements that are added to Nutro cat foods.

Two mineral premixes were affected at the US-based premix supplier. One premix contained excessive levels of zinc and under-supplemented potassium and the second premix was under-supplemented for potassium. An extensive review confirmed that only these two premixes were affected. **This recall does not affect any Nutro dog food products, wet cat food or dog and cat treats.**

Consumers who have purchased the affected product should immediately discontinue feeding the product to their cats. They should also monitor their cats for symptoms, including a reduction in appetite or refusal of food, weight loss, vomiting or diarrhea. If your cat is experiencing health issues or is pregnant, please contact your veterinarian.

Consumers who have purchased the affected product should return it to their retailer for a full refund or exchange for another Nutro dry cat food product.
