

MASSACHUSETTS SCHOOLS THAT PURCHASED LOCALLY GROWN FOODS DURING '08-'09 SCHOOL YEAR

AN INFORMAL SURVEY BY THE MASSACHUSETTS FARM TO SCHOOL PROJECT

The **205** districts below reported they preferentially purchased local foods during the '08-'09 school year. At least **80** of these districts purchased some or all of their local foods directly from more than **60** Massachusetts farms. There were about **603,000** students enrolled in the public schools listed below. This is **63%** of the total state-wide enrollment of about **959,000** pupils.

In addition, **49** Massachusetts colleges and private schools reported they preferentially purchased local foods during the '08-'09 school year.
