# Application for Registration of New Pesticide Products in Massachusetts

## A. **General Instructions for Completing the Pesticide Product Registration Form**

Before submitting the form, please make certain that all the information requested is clearly written in the spaces provided. **Failure to properly and fully complete this form will result in the return of all registration materials.**

Please submit separate checks for new product fees (\$300) and re-registration/renewal fees (\$250); applicable to, each different EPA Registration Number. **Combining different fees in one check will result in the return of all registration materials.**

## B. **Application Submission Instructions**

**Submit:** Two (2) individually stapled packets, each including the following:

1. Completed Massachusetts Application for New Product Registration.
2. Final EPA approved product labeling, as provided on the product/packaging.
3. Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for the new product.

**Plus:** One additional loose copy of the completed Massachusetts Application for New Product Registration Form.

## C. **Pesticide Product Registration Fees**

The fee for a new product registration is \$300 per each different EPA registration number. The fee for a product containing a NEW active ingredient not previously registered in Massachusetts is \$500. If you are unsure of the registration of an active ingredient, please contact Pesticide Product Registration. Checks should be made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and sent to the following address:

**NOTE:** The addition of a **distributor number** constitutes a different EPA Registration Number.

## D. **Pesticide Product Registration Process and Activity Period**

Pesticide product registration in Massachusetts is the responsibility of the Pesticide Board Subcommittee. All applications for registration will be processed as expeditiously as possible. Where practicable the Subcommittee shall approve and classify, or deny an application for registration within 90 days of receipt.

After the review and approval of an application, a certification of registration will be sent to the registrant. A registrant will receive written notification in the event that the Pesticide Board Subcommittee has amended or denied an application for registration.

The initial registration of a pesticide product shall be valid for a period beginning with the actual date of approval and ending on June 30<sup>th</sup>, unless it has been modified, suspended or revoked. Thereafter, the registration year will run from July 1 to June 30<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent year.
