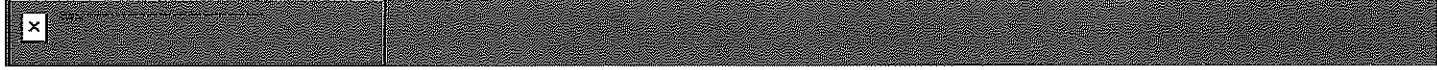

Describe the regulatory issue or observation:: A hoisters license is required to operate small equipment that lifts over 500lbs. To my knowledge, we are the only state with such a requirement. Many small rental stores, such as ours, have been forced to sell off our equipment since homeowners can no longer rent these items. Last year our business lost over \$40,000 in rental revenue due to this law.

Suggestions for improvements to the regulation:: Eliminate this law as the big national rental companies are ignoring it, while the little guys, who follow the laws struggle to survive.

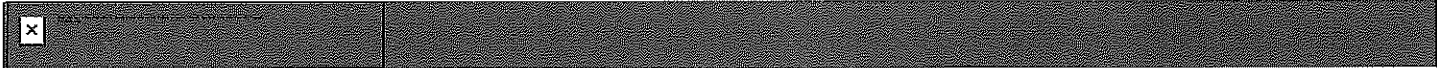

Describe the regulatory issue or observation:: Stretch Energy Code

Suggestions for improvements to the regulation:: Whereas the base energy code now is now implemented, please seriously consider a "Stretch" energy code that is in fact, a stretch. The HERS rating system gives the industry a clear and succinct measuring stick that will keep the statute from being overly-complex. For residential construction, the new stretch code should consider exceeding the base code by 15% (HERS of 40) to stay ahead of the base code. The Stretch code is a voluntary program, therefore, making the requirement rigorous will not negatively impact the economy, nor single out and group or groups of stakeholders unfairly.
