Contract Summary

The Operational Services Division, State Surplus Property Office is pleased to announce the establishment of a contract for the sale and removal of the following scrap metals :

Who Can Use This Contract?

Applicable Procurement Law: MGL c. 7, § 22; c. 30, § 51, § 52; 801 CMR 21.00

Eligible Entities:

01. Cities, towns, districts, counties and other political subdivisions
02. Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches, including all Departments and elected offices therein;
03. Independent public authorities, commissions and quasi-public agencies
04. Local public libraries, public school districts and charter schools;
05. Public Hospitals, owned by the Commonwealth;
06. Public institutions of high education
07. Public purchasing cooperatives;
08. Non-profit, UFR-certified organizations that are doing business with the Commonwealth;
09. Other states and territories with no prior approval by the State Purchasing Agent required; and

10. Other entities when designated in writing by the State Purchasing Agent.

How to Use This Contract:

- When an agency representative deems that there is at least 1 ton of scrap metal available for disposal, the representative shall contact the vendor and request the removal of the metal.
- If an agency requests a container to be dropped off at a specified location to be filled by the agency, the container must be loaded and ready for removal within a 60 day period. If a container is delivered to a location and not made ready for removal from the location within a two (2) month period, the vendor will have the right to charge \$100.00 per month beginning the **third month** a container remains at the location.
- The vendor must remove the metal no later than **one (1) week** from when the agency representative notifies them.
- Both the agency representative and the vendor must agree on what type of metal will be weighed prior to the removal of any metal from the holding site. Any problems, such as discrepancies on quality or type of the metal(s), must be resolved prior to removal. Once removal has taken place, it is the responsibility of the vendor to pay the quoted price for the load.
- Except for wood and other non-metal debris, the vendor will be required to take all metal in the pile. As specified earlier, discrepancies on quality or type of metal must be reported to SSPO prior to removal. Vendors will not be allowed to remove only the metal they want and leave the remainder.
- It is the responsibility of the vendor to do their own loading of the scrap metal into containers that are suitable for transport. The transport of all metals must be done by vehicles that have passed all Massachusetts Inspection regulations. Vehicles that will be used must be appropriate for the transport of metals. Vendor will not be allowed exceed the maximum load capacity of their vehicles. In order to avoid road mishaps, the vendor will not be allowed to remove the metal off the holding site unless all metal is secured and covered. Vendors will not be allowed to transport metal in open bed vehicles.
- The vendor may be allowed to drop off a container so the agency can load their own metal(s). If this is the case, the agency must take care to only load metal into the container and it will be the responsibility of the agency to contact the vendor when the container is ready to be removed from the location.

- On the day of removal a representative from the agency will accompany the vendor to the nearest weigh station for a determination of the value of the metal. At the time of weigh-in, the agency representative will be present in order to verify the weight of the metal. In the rare event there is no agency representative present at the weigh site, it is the responsibility of the vendor to send a copy of the weight slip both the agency and to SSPO.
- All fees charged for weighing the metal at the weigh station will be the responsibility of the vendor.
- After the metal has been weighed, each party will sign the original weight slip and one copy, and specify the type of metal weighed. The agency representative will keep the original and the vendor will receive the copy.
- The agency representative will then send a copy of the weight slip to either MassDOT or SSPO indicating the amount of money due from the vendor.

Submission of Payment by Awarded Vendors

- 1. MassDOT Scrap Metals:** If metal(s) are removed/received from any **Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT)** location, a copy of each weight slip along with payment must be sent to

- 2. All other State agencies:** If metal(s) are removed/received from any other State agency location, a copy of each weight slip along with payment must be sent to:

- Full payment and a copy of all weight slips from the vendor must be received within **Seven (7) business days** from the removal date of scrap metal. Vendors who submit checks without the corresponding weight slips will not be acceptable.
- **Important!** *Vendors who remove scrap metals from non-executive state departments (e.g. political subdivisions such as cities, towns, and other qualified entities) will be required to submit payment along with copies of the weight slips directly to the entity. Discrepancies such as quality or type of metal will also be resolved between the eligible entity and vendor.*
- Any vendor who does not adhere to all of the above requirements will receive a written warning. If the vendor does not correct **any** performance discrepancy within seven (7) business days from the date of the written warning, the vendor will be notified in writing he has been found in default and has lost the contract.
- **If scrap metal is delivered to vendor:** In the event a state agency or political subdivision wishes to deliver their scrap metal instead of having the vendor remove it, all procedures outlined previously will be followed with the exception of transport procedures. State agencies and political subdivisions must contact vendor no later than 24 hours prior to make an appointment to deliver the metal. It is advisable if using this method of disposal users pay close attention to the quality and type of metal that is being delivered in order to avoid discrepancy issues with the vendor.
