The **Massachusetts Office on Disability (MOD)** is now **accepting submissions** for our **2017 Call for Art** and juried art exhibition. We are calling on talented Massachusetts residents of all abilities to submit their original artwork.

Selected entries will be displayed at a public **exhibition at the Massachusetts State House** in late 2017 and in an online gallery.

A central purpose in holding this exhibition is to showcase the talent of our Commonwealth residents and to present works to the public that will raise awareness of and challenge the barriers and stigma that persons with disabilities encounter. Artists who enter the Call for Art will have an opportunity to gain statewide exposure and recognition in addition to experiencing the process of entering their work for consideration for display in a juried art show.
