

Complaint to Establish Paternity form instructions

SEE G.L. c.209C

The following must be filed with this complaint:

A copy of the child's birth certificate

Affidavit of Care and Custody

(form available at the courthouse)

Please Note: You **must** file a separate complaint for each child.

No filing fee is required.

Service of complaint on defendant is to be made in accordance with
Massachusetts Rules of Domestic Relations Procedure Rule 4

Financial Statements

Short form or Long form

Child Support Guidelines Worksheet if support for child is requested.

Attorneys are required to file Uniform Counsel Certification form.
