

2) Adjudications of Delinquency (Juvenile Convictions)

The commission is discussing adopting a provision that would, for purposes of sentencing guidelines calculations, change the treatment of juvenile prior convictions or adjudications of delinquency. The provision follows.

Juvenile Record. No prior adjudication of delinquency for a misdemeanor shall be counted for criminal history placement on the sentencing grid. Prior adjudications of delinquency for a felony shall be counted for criminal history placement on the sentencing grid where (1) the defendant is 25 years old or younger; and (2) the defendant was 14 years old or older when the felony offense was committed.
