3 THE CLERK: Jorge Zambrano is before you, Judge. He's
4 arrested. New charges. Docket no. 1662-CR-3389 in
5 Worcester May 16, 2016, operating a motor vehicle. License

7 violation to conceal identity.

1 THE PROSECUTOR: I'm just going to ask you to amend to
2 Count 1 to a subsequent offense. He has a number of prior -
3 - similar charges on his record and some of them are prior
4 to convictions, found guilty and fined.

5 THE COURT: All right. The Court will do that. Count
6 1 is going to be amended to reflect that it is operating
7 with a suspended license, subsequent offense.

8 THE PROBATION OFFICER: Your Honor, probation is not
9 asking for detention. They just would like to serve him
10 with an amended violation.

11 THE COURT: Okay.

12 Mr. Zambrano, the record will reflect that probation is
13 serving you with an amended notice of violation in hand
14 today.

15 THE CLERK: You're going to be released, sir, on
16 personal recognizance. You are further advised if charged
17 with a new offense while on recognizance on these matters,
18 your recognizance may be revoked and you could be held up to
19 90 days awaiting trial. Matters are going to be continued
20 to June 9th at 9:00 a.m. in courtroom 15 for pretrial
21 conference, pretrial conference hearing and violation of
22 probation. He's released.

23 THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, Your Honor.
