

Massachusetts Coastal and Estuarine Land Conservation Program Summary of Projects Nominated to NOAA for National Competition

FFY 2012

- **Nasketucket Bay State Reservation Expansion:**
Mattapoisett and Fairhaven, 208 acre mixture of fee simple and conservation easement acquisition, 3922 feet of shoreline, extensive *BioMap 2 Core Habitat*, *Critical Natural Landscape*, and *Coastal Adaptation Priority Areas*, *NHESP Priority Habitat for Rare Species*, and *NHESP Coastal Maritime Forest Priority Vegetation Community*, \$2,530,000 CELCP Funds requested. Ranking for 2012 projects is not available.

FFY 2011

- **Magnolia Hill Conservation Project:**
Gloucester, 109 acre acquisition of conservation easement, extensive *Biomap Core Habitat*, adjacent to 1650 acres of protected lands, \$3,000,000 CELCP funds requested. Ranked 23 nationally out of 42 projects.

FFY 2010

- **Magnolia Hill Conservation Project:**
Gloucester, 109 acre acquisition of conservation easement, extensive *Biomap Core Habitat*, adjacent to 1650 acres of protected lands, \$3,000,000 CELCP funds requested. Ranked 18 nationally out of 57 projects.
- **Nasketucket Bay Land Protection Project:**
Mattapoisett and Fairhaven, 286 acre mixture of fee simple and conservation easement acquisition, 3922 feet of coastal shoreline, extensive *Priority Habitat for rare species*, proposed expansion of Nasketucket Bay State Reservation, \$2,800,000 CELCP funds requested. Ranked 23 nationally out of 57 projects.

FFY 2009

- **Great Neck Conservation Partnership Project:**
Wareham, 95 acre acquisition of conservation easement, 7200 feet of coastal frontage including 3400 feet of fringing salt marsh, \$2,300,000 CELCP Funds requested--\$1,986,500 CELCP funds received. Ranked 3 nationally out of 46 projects.

FFY 2008

- **Herring River Land Acquisition and Restoration Project:**
Wellfleet, 25 acre acquisition facilitating 1100 acre restoration, 1380 feet of coastal frontage, \$2,532,000 CELCP funds requested. Ranked 41 nationally out of 43 projects.
- **Apponagansett Bay/Weinshel Farm Conservation Project:**
Dartmouth, 74 acre acquisition, 3500 feet of fringing salt marsh, \$3,000,000 CELCP funds requested. This was the second year the project was nominated. Ranked 16 nationally out of 43 projects.

FFY 2007

- **Center Hill Beach Conservation Project:**
Plymouth, 78 acre acquisition, approximately 2500 feet of beach, \$2,263,500 CELCP funds requested and received. Ranked 2 nationally out of 41 projects.
- **Apponagansett Bay/Weinshel Farm Conservation Project:**
Dartmouth, 74 acre acquisition, 3500 feet of fringing salt marsh, \$3,000,000 CELCP funds requested. Ranked 21 nationally out of 41 projects.
- **Ipswich River/Great Marsh, Perkins/Treadwell Island Conservation Project:**
Ipswich, 130 acre acquisition including 100 acres salt marsh, \$540,250 CELCP funds requested. Project determined by NOAA to be not eligible and not ranked nationally.
