Grant Notification

Town of Wareham

“The Wareham Police Department has been notified recently that we are eligible to apply to the Bureau of Justice Assistance for funds under Justice Assistance Grant. The Plymouth County District Attorney’s Office is the official applicant joining with the communities of Brockton, Wareham, and Plymouth. Wareham is eligible to apply for **\$12,204.90** for crime prevention, equipment, technology, information systems and public safety initiatives. The funds are available to use over a four year period of time. Community input will be accepted until **June 9, 2014**

It is our intention to utilize these funds to, purchase equipment, and make improvements in areas that would be otherwise curtailed through lack of other funding sources. Namely, it is our intent to purchase equipment that will continue our commitment to provide our officers with the necessary equipment and resources to do their job. The funds are available over the next four years.
