*What's the 411 on
Disc (Frisbee) Golf?*

Disc golf is an exciting sport that is both fun and inexpensive. The sport offers players of all ages and abilities a game that is healthy, challenging and rewarding. Disc golf is played similar to traditional golf, but instead of a golf club and ball, disc golf is played with a specialized Frisbee (disc), and an elevated metal basket (picture above). Players throw the disc from the "tee" to the "basket" via a fairway. Courses utilize terrain changes, trees, shrubs, and wind to create challenging holes. Most importantly, disc golf is played in a beautiful setting, and the purpose is to have fun with friends and family while participating in something challenging and relaxing.

Directions to facilities:

Castle Island (Fort Independence):

Rte 93 to exit 15, North or South follow beach along William J. Day Blvd, Castle Island is at the end of the Causeway.

Via the T - Red Line to Broadway Station, take City Point Bus #9 or #11. Walk to the right across Marine Park to the beach to the entrance of the fort.

Carson Beach & Mother's Rest:

Rte. 93 North to exit 15 at bottom of ramp take a left. 93 South to exit 15 at bottom of ramp take a right. Follow beach along William J. Day Blvd to bathhouse located at 165 William J. Day Blvd. Free parking is available.

Via the T - Red line to JFK Station follow the signs to William J. Day Blvd.

Pope John Paul II Park:

Rte. 93 South to exit 12 and merge onto Gallivan Blvd (MA203). The entrance is located after the Walgreens. Driving 93 North to exit 11 will bring you to Granite Ave at the first light take a right; this will put you on Hilltop St. Follow to end at the end. Take a right onto Gallivan Blvd. The entrance is on the right just pass Walgreens. A second entrance is on Hallet St off of Hilltop St.

Via the T - Take the Red Line (Ashmont Branch) to Fields Corner. The #20 bus route passes by two of the parks entrances: at Neponset Circle and Hallet St.

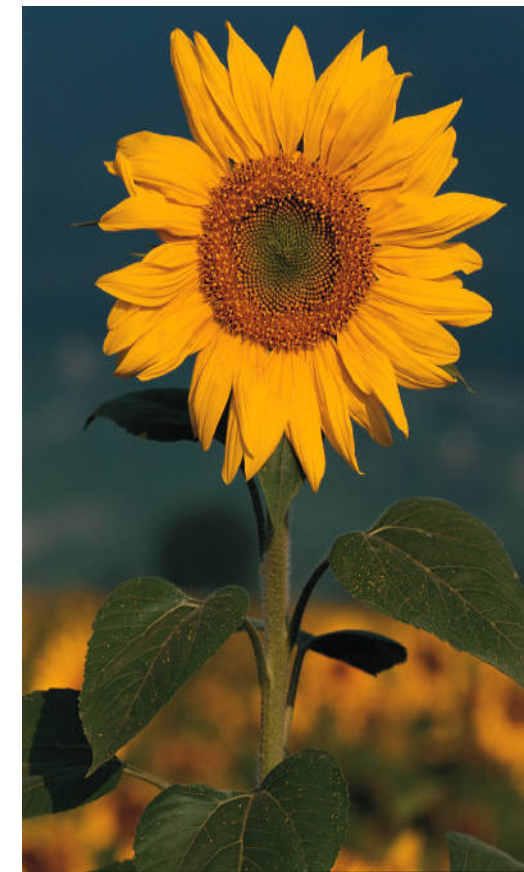

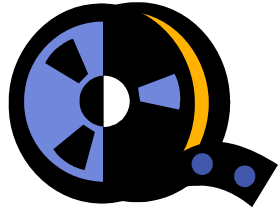

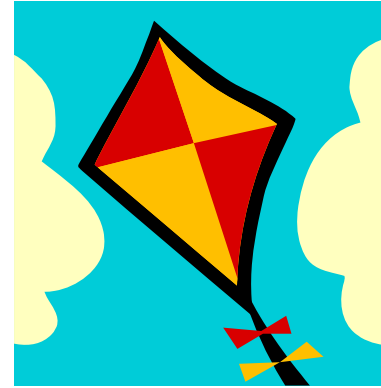
