DCR Traffic Advisory: Storrow Drive Tunnel Repair Schedule and Storrow Drive at the Longfellow Bridge Lane Closures

Storrow Drive Tunnel Repair Schedule:

WHAT: As part of the ongoing Storrow Drive Tunnel Repair, instrumentation equipment will be installed on the steel beams on the following schedule:

- December 4 -9, 2011, 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM, left lane closure
- December 11 – 16, 2011, 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM, Right lane closure
- December 19 – 23, 2011, 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM, Right lane closure
- December 27 – 29, 2011, 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM, Right lane closure

WHERE: Storrow Drive Tunnel

WHEN: Ongoing from Dec. 4 through December 29. See above schedule. Overnight.

Storrow Drive and Memorial Drive at Longfellow Bridge Construction Lane Restrictions for the week of December 4 – December 10:

WHAT: As part of the ongoing Storrow Drive and Memorial Drive road repairs at the Longfellow Bridge, the following lane closures will be in effect.
