Notice is hereby given that the Executive Office for Administration and Finance, working with the Department of Conservation and Recreation, acting under statutory authority of Chapter 7 of the General Laws and line item 2800-0100 of section 2 of Chapter 182 of the Acts of 2008, and in conformance with Chapter 30A of the General Laws, is holding a public hearing on proposed amendments to portions of 801 CMR 4.02 regarding fees charged for certain services provided at facilities of the Department of Conservation and Recreation. The proposed amendments would create a new "combination" fee charged for the contemporaneous rental of both small and large rinks at DCR-operated ice skating rinks.

A public hearing will be conducted to receive verbal and written comments on the proposed regulations.
