**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT AND HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Conservation and Recreation, acting under statutory authority of Chapter 21, section 1; Chapter 92, sections 33, 35, 37, 38; and Chapter 132A, sections 7, 7A of the General Laws, and in conformance with Chapter 30A of the General Laws, is holding public hearings on proposed regulations found at 302 CMR 11.00 and proposed amendments to a portion of 350 CMR 2.00 relating to construction and access permits required for certain activities sought to be undertaken on Department of Conservation and Recreation property. The proposed regulation would outline the activities for which construction and access permits are required, as well as the process by which such permits may be applied for and issued. The proposed amendments serve to rescind 350 CMR 2.08.

Two public hearings will be conducted to receive verbal and written comments on the proposed regulations.
