DCR INSTITUTES PARKING BAN

“No parking” ban in effect on DCR roadways; vehicles in violation will be towed

WHAT: In anticipation of a snow emergency on Friday, December 19, 2008, Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) Commissioner Richard K. Sullivan Jr. today declared a parking ban on DCR roadways in Greater Boston, effective Friday morning. During the emergency, parking is prohibited on any DCR road, street, or parkway that is posted with “Snow Emergency” signs. Prohibiting parking allows snowplows to clear the roadways effectively. State Police will tow vehicles violating the parking ban.
