### **DCR HOLDING PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS FINAL DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION PLANS, AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS FOR MT. VERNON STREET AND PATTEN'S COVE BRIDGES**

**WHAT:** The Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will hold a public meeting to discuss the final design, construction plans, and traffic impacts for the rehabilitation of two bridges on Morrissey Boulevard in Dorchester: Mt. Vernon Street and Patten's Cove.

As part of Governor Patrick's \$3 billion Accelerated Bridge Program, aimed at quickly repairing the Commonwealth's most neglected bridges, DCR recently awarded a \$6.2 million contract to WES Construction Corporation for the full rehabilitation of the two bridges. Work is expected to begin later this summer.
