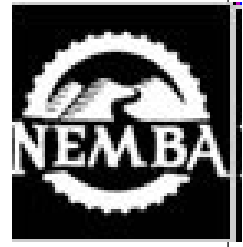

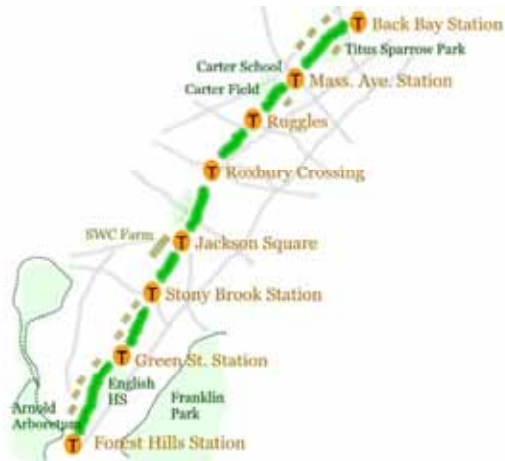

Partnerships Matching Funds Program

- \$1.35 million program
 - FY 2010 - 29 Projects, \$1,117,664 in partner contributions
 - DCR has \$700,000 for projects for FY 2011
- Applications accepted from Friends/park advocacy groups, civic organizations, institutions, businesses, and non-state public entities.
- FY 2011 applications due December 17, 2010, with January 14, 2011 notification
 - FY' 2012 to launch in late March '11, with June notification

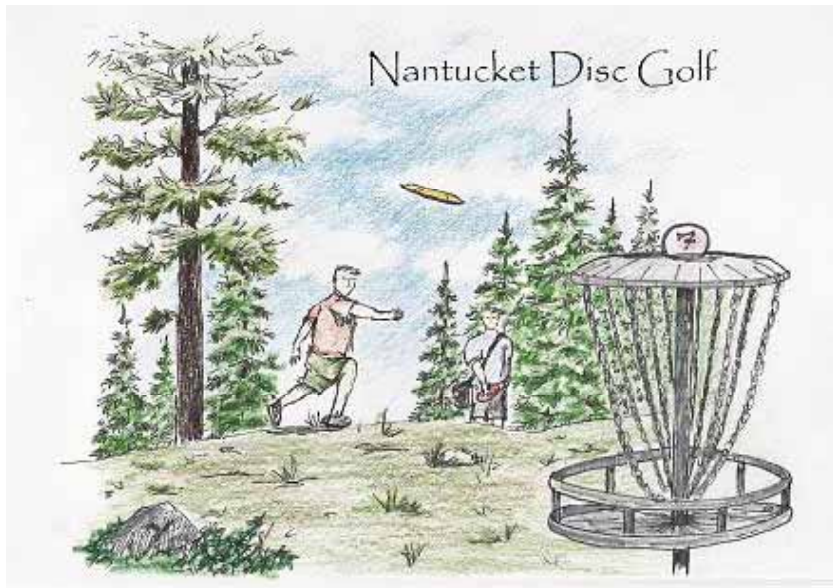
