Following the Marian Fathers' conservation lead, the Kampoosa Bog Drainage Basin was designated an Area of Critical Environmental Concern by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in 1995.

Directions:

Take Mass. Turnpike to Exit 2, Lee.

Follow Rt. 102 west to Stockbridge. Continue on Main Street past the Rt. 7 junction into Stockbridge town center.

From the center of Stockbridge:

- Turn north onto Pine Street, directly across Main Street from the Red Lion Inn at the Civil War Monument
- Proceed directly up the hill (Heaton Hall sign will be on your left) to the Marian Fathers property, Eden Hill
- Once on the Marian Fathers property continue straight ahead to a parking lot on the right
- The event will take place under the tent in the field overlooking Kamposa Bog
