Notice of Registration of Hydrogen Peroxide-Generating Algaecides for Use in Lakes and Ponds

In accordance with the MEPA special review conditions at 301 CMR 11.09 and the Secretary's certificate on the Final Generic Environmental Impact Report, *Eutrophication and Aquatic Plant Management in Massachusetts* (GEIR) (EOEA 0011/6934) of February 11, 2004, the following notice is provided.

On Wednesday, July 21, 2010 the Pesticide Board Subcommittee registered the following 5 hydrogen peroxide-generating algaecides for use in lakes and ponds:

Granular product formulations based on sodium carbonate peroxyhydrate:

- Phycomycin-SCP Algaecide and Oxidizer, EPA Reg. No. 68660-9-8959;
- GreenClean Pro, EPA Reg. No. 70299-6;
- PAK 27, EPA Reg. No. 68660-9; and
- Algae-Off Ag Pro, EPA Reg. No. 80876-2.

Liquid product formulation based on hydrogen peroxide and peracetic acid:

- GreenClean Broad Spectrum, EPA Reg. No. 70299-2;

The reviews conducted by Massachusetts Department of Agricultural Resources (MDAR) and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Office of Research and Standards, for the purpose of registration, will be integrated into a single review document which will serve as a reference for the approval of the use of hydrogen peroxide-generating algaecides in lakes and ponds. The integrated review will be posted on the MDAR website and will be integrated as an addendum into Appendix III of the final Generic Environmental Impact Report on *Eutrophication and Aquatic Plant Management in Massachusetts*.
