Introduction

MassDEP *Forms*, as well as *Instructions & Supporting Materials*, are available for download from the MassDEP Web site at mass.gov/dep in two file formats: Microsoft Word™ and Adobe Acrobat PDF™. Either format allows documents to be printed.

Instructions & Supporting Materials files in Microsoft Word™ format contain a series of documents that provide guidance on how to prepare a submittal. Although we recommend that you print out the entire package, you may choose to print specific documents by selecting the appropriate page numbers for printing.

Forms in Microsoft Word™ format must be downloaded separately. Users with Microsoft Word™ 97 or later may complete these forms electronically.

Submittal packages in Adobe Acrobat PDF™ format combine *Forms* and *Instructions & Supporting Materials* in a single document. Adobe Acrobat PDF™ files may only be viewed and printed without alteration. *Forms* in this format may not be completed electronically.

MassDEP strongly recommends that retail sellers thoroughly review the *Form* and *Instructions* before beginning to complete the BWP AQ 32 Form. Please note that the spreadsheet at <http://www.mass.gov/dep/air/approvals/aqforms.htm#ghg> must be completed before you can complete the form.



BWP AQ 32 Mandatory Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Form and Spreadsheet for Retail Sellers of Electricity Instructions and Supporting Materials

1. What is the purpose of this submittal?

The purpose of this mandatory BWP AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet is to allow retail sellers subject to MassDEP regulation 310 CMR 7.71(9) "Reporting Requirements for Retail Sellers of Electricity" to report their annual greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions released in the course of generating the electricity they sell. The AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet must be submitted by all retail sellers subject to MassDEP regulation 310 CMR 7.71(9), whether or not they submitted BWP AQ 31, the "Optional Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Form for Retail Sellers of Electricity."

2. Who must submit?

All retail sellers that sold electricity in Massachusetts during the reporting year must submit this Form and Spreadsheet. "Retail Seller" means a competitive supplier licensed by the Department of Public Utilities or, as each is defined in Massachusetts General Law (MGL) chapter 164A §1, an electric utility, municipal electric department or municipal light board.

3. What is the overall process for retail sellers to determine their GHG emissions?

Draft emission factors (EFs) are posted by the Department each year, reflecting draft average emission rates that do not account for ownership and/or use of particular generation sources. After accounting for the MWh and emissions on optional Form BWP AQ 31 submittals, and any comments received on the draft EFs, the final EFs are posted.

Retail sellers must use the final EFs as posted by the Department in determining their annual GHG emissions to be reported on BWP AQ 32 "Mandatory Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Form for Retail Sellers of Electricity." These annual emission factors will be included each year in the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet. Retail sellers will determine GHG emissions (in short tons) by:

- multiplying:
 - their electricity sales (in megawatt hours, MWh)(less any non-emitting and emitting generation sources submitted on optional Form BWP AQ 31) by
 - final EFs (in pounds of GHG per megawatt hour, lb GHG/MWh) by
 - 1 short ton per 2000 pounds
- and adding the emissions of any particular generation sources submitted on optional Form BWP AQ 31.

The BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet will perform the above calculation. Retail Sellers will need to complete the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet before completing the BWP AQ 32 Form.

4. What are the submittal deadlines for the BWP AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet?

The submittal deadlines for the BWP AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet vary by the year in which the emissions occurred.

For emissions that occurred in the course of generating electricity in:

- 2008: the regulation at 310 CMR 7.71(9)(b)1. requires that "an initial report shall be submitted within 30 days after the Department posts on its website in 2010 the final annual emission factors listed in 310 CMR 7.71(9)(c)..." MassDEP is releasing this mandatory BWP AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet at the same time as the final annual EFs for 2008 emissions. Retail sellers must submit this form and spreadsheet by 5 pm on January 21, 2011.
- 2009: the regulation does not require a submittal for emissions released by generating electricity in 2009.

- 2010 and later years: retail sellers must submit the mandatory BWP AQ 32 Form and Spreadsheet “by the first day of the next month that is a full calendar month after the Department posts on its website the final annual emission factors listed in 310 CMR 7.71(9)(c).”

5. How should I enter the information on the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet? (See question 8 for instructions on entering MWh and emissions on the BWP AQ 32 Form)

All Retail Sellers must enter the MWh sold during the reporting year in the blue box in Step 1 of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet. For retail sellers subject to the Massachusetts Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS), the MWh must be the same as the amount provided to DOER. For municipal electric departments and light boards, the MWh must be the same as the amount reported to the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities in their “annual return” on page 57, line 15.

The blue box for Non-Emitting MWh in Step 2 of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet may only be filled out if the retail seller submitted non-emitting MWh on the optional Form BWP AQ 31 for the corresponding emissions year. If Form BWP AQ 31 was submitted, the non-emitting MWh entered in Step 2 of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet must be the same as were reported on Part B of Form BWP AQ 31.

Similarly, the three blue boxes in Step 3 of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet for Emitting MWh and for Non-Biogenic and Biogenic Emissions may only be completed if the retail seller submitted emitting MWh and CO₂e emissions on the optional Form BWP AQ 31 for the corresponding emissions year. If the Form BWP AQ 31 was submitted, the emitting MWh, non-biogenic CO₂e emissions, and biogenic CO₂e emissions entered in Step 2 of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet must be the same as were reported on Part C of Form BWP AQ 31.

Please note that any MWh or emissions entered into blue boxes for the MA-Based emissions calculation will automatically propagate to the Regional emissions calculation on the right hand side of the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet. If non-emitting and/or emitting MWh were not submitted on Form BWP AQ 31 for the corresponding reporting year, please leave the blue boxes in Step 2 and/or Step 3 blank, as appropriate.

6. If I did not submit the optional Form BWP AQ 31, may I still include my non-emitting and emitting MWh on the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet?

No. Because the final EFs account for BWP AQ 31 submittals, you may only include non-emitting or low-emitting MWhs on the AQ 32 Spreadsheet if those MWhs were submitted on Form BWP AQ 31 for that reporting year.

7. If I am a competitive supplier, where do I find my Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities (MassDPU) license number to enter in Part A of Form BWP AQ 32?

8. How do I complete the boxes for MWh, Non-biogenic and Biogenic Emissions on the BWP AQ 32 Form?

- (1) All Retail Sellers must enter the Emissions Reporting Year.
- (2) The MWh sold during that reporting year and the non-biogenic and biogenic MA-Based and Regional emissions in CO₂e must be transferred from the BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet to the BWP AQ 32 Form.

9. In what format and to whom do I send my BWP AQ 32 Form and BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet?

- (1) Submit electronic copies of the BWP AQ 32 Form in Word or Adobe format and the accompanying BWP AQ 32 Spreadsheet (in spreadsheet format, to show calculations) to MassDEP by email to: sue.ann.richardson@state.ma.us
- (2) Submit one hardcopy of all materials to: Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Waste Prevention, 1 Winter Street, Boston, MA 02108, Attn: Sue Ann Richardson.

10. What are the reporting fees and timelines?

As of December 1, 2010, reporting under BWP AQ 32 “Mandatory Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reporting Form for Retail Sellers of Electricity” is not subject to 310 CMR 4.00 and therefore is not subject to fees and review timelines established under that regulation.

11. What is the annual compliance fee?

As of December 1, 2010 there is no annual compliance fee specifically for this program.

12. What are the regulations that apply to these submittals? Where can I get copies?
