# Chapter 4 of the Acts of 2009

- Effective July 1, 2009
- Implementation of UST program under 527 CMR 9.00 Tanks and Containers transfers from Dept. of Fire Safety (DFS) to MassDEP
- MassDEP assumes responsibility for 527 CMR 5.06 Inventory
- DFS retains parts of UST program



# What to do on/after July 1

- 7/1/09 – MassDEP will use existing DFS forms to implement those sections of 527 CMR 9.00 coming to MassDEP.
- NOT all UST-Related Forms come to MassDEP. See Transition Fact Sheet for more detailed breakdown
