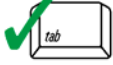

Generator Registration

Instructions for Completing a Generator Registration Form

- When filling out forms on the computer, use only the tab key to move your cursor - do not use the return key.
- If you generate 27 gallons or more of hazardous waste or 270 gallons or more of waste oil in any calendar month, you should complete a Notification of Hazardous Waste Activity form, not the attached registration form. That form and further information can be accessed at this address: <http://www.mass.gov/dep/recycle/approvals/hwactvty.pdf>
- Check off if you are registering as a Small Quantity Generator of Waste Oil, Very Small Quantity Generator of Waste Oil, or a Very Small Quantity Generator of Hazardous Waste. You can be both a waste oil generator and a hazardous waste generator. Note that Small Quantity Generators of Waste Oil have additional hazardous waste management requirements.

- If you do not already have a MAD, MAR, MAV or MA5 Number, enter MV, followed by your Area Code and Telephone Number as your Generator Registration Number.
- Enter your business' North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code. A list of codes commonly used for VSQGs is attached. More information on these Classification Codes can be found at: <http://www.census.gov/eos/www/naics/>
- Return the signed original to the appropriate DEP Regional Office.
- **Keep a copy of your registration form. This will be your receipt of registration. DEP will not send a confirmation.**

Rules for Massachusetts Very Small Quantity Generators

- Register with DEP
- Never accumulate more than 2,200 lbs. (approx. 270 gallons or five 55-gallon drums) at any one time
- Store your hazardous wastes on an impervious surface in a separate secured area identified as "HAZARDOUS WASTE" (if outdoors, liquid wastes must have secondary containment)
- Label your hazardous waste containers – HAZARDOUS WASTE, with the name of the waste and the hazard associated with it, e.g. corrosive, toxic, ignitable
- Obtain a receipt for your waste, or retain in your files a copy of the manifest
- Retain records of the type and quantity, date and method of treatment or disposal of your waste
- The complete regulatory requirements for VSQG are found in the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Regulations section 310 CMR 30.353. The complete regulatory requirements for SQG of Waste Oil are referenced in section 310 CMR 30.253 (5) b. Copies of these regulations are available at www.mass.gov/dep/recycle/laws/regulati.htm or from the State House Book Store.

Rules for Self Transporting Waste for Massachusetts Very Small Quantity Generators

If you are a Very Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste or waste oil, you may self-transport your waste according to the following rules:

- Transport only your own waste
- Do **not** transport acutely hazardous waste
- Transport no more than 55 gallons a trip
- Label your containers properly:
- Seal container tightly and secure to vehicle
- Keep a copy of your VSQG registration in your vehicle
- Obtain a receipt for your waste
- Keep your receipts for three years
