Enclosed please find a Level III Class B(3) Hazardous Waste Recycling Permit to market specification used oil fuel issued to NewStream LLC, 527 Pleasant Street, Unit 11D, Attleboro, Massachusetts 02703. This permit is issued pursuant to Chapter. 21C, of the General Laws and 310 CMR 30.200.

This permit is an action of the Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) and shall become effective twenty-one (21) days after issuance. If you are aggrieved by this action, you may request an adjudicatory hearing. A request for a hearing must be made in writing and postmarked within twenty-one (21) days of the date of this letter.

Under 310 CMR 1.01(6)(b), the request must state clearly and concisely the facts, which are the grounds for the request, and the relief sought. Additionally, the request must state why the permit is not consistent with applicable laws and regulations.

The hearing request, along with a valid check payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the amount of \$100.00, must be mailed to:

The request for a hearing will be dismissed if the filing fee is not paid, unless the appellant is exempt or granted a waiver as described below.

The MassDEP may waive the adjudicatory hearing filing fee for a person who shows that paying the fee will create an undue financial hardship. A person seeking a waiver must file, together with the hearing request as provided above, setting forth the facts believed to support the claim of undue financial hardship.

If you are in agreement with the terms and conditions set forth in the permit, please sign both copies of the certification page within ten (10) days and forward a signed copy to the Department of Environmental Protection, Southeast Regional Office, Bureau of Waste Prevention, 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville, MA 02347, Attn: Christopher Tilden, P.E., Regional Engineer.
