ATTACHMENT A

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Pioneer Valley Energy Center, LLC proposed to be located at Ampad Road, Westfield, Massachusetts, (the “permittee”) is authorized to discharge pretreated industrial wastewater to the City of Westfield sewer system.
2. This Permit expires five (5) years from the date of issuance. The permittee shall apply for a renewal of this Permit at least 90 days prior to the expiration date in accordance with 314 CMR 7.09 (3)(b).
3. This Permit is subject to obtaining approval of any other applicable federal, state or local authority that may have jurisdiction.
4. Industrial wastewater discharged from the site shall be in compliance with the EPA General Pretreatment Regulations for Existing and New Sources of Pollution (40 CFR 403), the City of Westfield Sewer Use Ordinance and Industrial Pretreatment Program (“IPP”), any industrial discharge permit issued by the City of Westfield, and the local effluent limitations established therein. The most stringent limitations shall prevail.
5. The permittee shall conduct all sampling and monitoring in accordance with 40 CFR 136.
6. Concentrated chemicals and hazardous materials/wastes are prohibited from being discharged to the sewer.
7. No person owning, maintaining or using a sewer connection shall discharge or allow the discharge of wastewater through such connection which would result in a hazard to the public health or safety or a violation of the provisions of 314 CMR 7.00 or 12.00.
