NARRATIVE

General Description / Forest Composition and History:

Lot 3150 is located inside DCR-DWSP Gate 18 at the end of Hunt Road in New Salem, just east of Lot 3144, which was completed in 2016. The main forest types in the harvest area are White Pine/Oak, White Pine/Hardwood, and Oak/Hardwood, with most of the cutting to occur in areas where the canopy is dominated by white pine overtopping black birch saplings and poles.

The goals for the harvest are to increase the age and species diversity of the forest through group selection with retention. Areas targeted for cutting have poorly formed and unhealthy white pine over a near monoculture of black birch saplings and poles. Oaks and other species of hardwoods were retained as seed sources in order to encourage a more diverse regeneration response.

There are no streams or wetlands in the harvest area. The dominant soil types are Millsite-Woodstock complex, Millsite-Chichester complex, and Montauk, Chichester, Metacomet, and Scituate fine sandy loams.

Site Selection:

This harvest is intended to help improve species and age diversity of the forest to achieve DWSP goals for forest age class and species diversity. Historically, intense browse reduced the species diversity of tree regeneration for several decades within the Quabbin, where hunting was not allowed and natural predators were absent. Deer, and more recently moose, preferentially browsed some species (such as oaks and maples) while leaving others (primarily white pine and black birch), resulting in low understory species diversity, as is the case in this lot. This harvest is a first step in reversing that process and restoring native biodiversity.

Silvicultural Objectives:

This harvest will open up new regeneration opportunities, both by stimulating seed production and by providing light for new and existing seedlings and saplings to grow. In order to increase species diversity, individuals of the most common species (white pine and black birch) have been prioritized for removal, while locally uncommon hardwood species have been prioritized for retention. Maximum opening size is 2 acres, large enough to allow regeneration of even shade intolerant species such as black cherry. Smaller (½ to 1 acre) openings were located on the steeper slopes in the oak-hardwood stand. Groups have been located where overstory trees have poor form and vigor and understory diversity is low. Advance regeneration is being retained and protected wherever possible.

Cultural Resources:

This lot contains stone walls both in the interior and along the lot boundaries. Additionally there is an old stone-lined well located adjacent to the lot, but outside of any area of harvest activity.

All cultural features are being protected and avoided as much as possible. Existing barways (breaks in walls) are being utilized in order to minimize damage to walls.

Rare or Endangered Species:

This lot contains no known rare or endangered species.
