I. Consideration of the Tentative Decision concerning the Petitions by Park City Wind LLC (formerly known as Vineyard Wind LLC) for approval pursuant to G.L. c. 164, §§ 69J, 72, and G.L. c. 40A, § 3, to construct and operate: (1) two 275-kilovolt ("kV") offshore cables that would follow a 63-mile route from a wind turbine array in federal waters to landfall beneath Craigville Beach in Barnstable, of which 23 miles are in Massachusetts waters; (2) two 275 kV cables traversing four miles of Barnstable's roadways in an underground duct bank; (3) a new Onshore Substation in Barnstable; and (4) a 345 kV 0.7-mile underground transmission line within an existing transmission line corridor connecting with the existing West Barnstable Substation.
