## Seal Watching at Ellisville Tuesday, February 20, 1:00 pm—4:00 pm

Park staff will be at the beach to help you spot seals basking along the shore at low tide. Although wildlife sightings are never guaranteed, we have a good chance of seeing a seal or two if it's a sunny afternoon.



Park at the main dirt parking lot at 1861 State Road (Route 3A) in Plymouth. Follow signed trail to beach, about 0.5 miles. Once on the beach, look for Interpreter Amy and she'll share some information about our Massachusetts seals and help you spot a basking seal or two, hopefully! Even if we don't see any seals, exploring the beach in winter is always fun. Drop by anytime between 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm; stay for as long as you like.

Best for curious adults and families with children ages 8+ years. All children must be accompanied by an adult. Dress for the weather. No dogs, please. Program is free, no parking fees. No restrooms on site; plan accordingly. Inclement weather will cancel. For more information or to confirm in case of questionable weather, call (508) 272-9376.
