




Radioactive Waste Shipments - Planned

On November 9, a violation of the facility's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit was reported to USEPA and MassDEP. The violation involved the pumping of approximately 7,250 gallons of rain and groundwater from an underground cable vault to an adjacent storm sewer. A corresponding report was made to the USNRC due to the environmental report made to a government agency.

The water was non-radiological and no visible sheen or odor were noted. Laboratory analysis is being performed to determine the presence of any pollutants. A causal analysis is being performed to determine what process or performance issues contributed to the event.

Event was self-identified and was captured & placed in our corrective action process.
