

Results of MassHealth RFR for Personal Care Management Functions for the
MassHealth Personal Care Attendant (PCA) Program

On May 15, 2019, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS) issued a Request for Responses (RFR) pursuant to 801 CMR 21.00 to solicit responses from qualified entities to conduct Personal Care Management (PCM) functions for the MassHealth Personal Care Attendant (PCA) Program (130 CMR 422.000). PCM functions include a broad range of support functions that assist Consumers with the management of their PCA services.
