### **Important**

### **If you need to amend your return**

If you need to amend or correct the return you filed electronically, you must complete and file a Massachusetts Form CA-6, Application for Abatement/Amended Return. Please contact your paid preparer to inquire about filing this form electronically or the MDOR Customer Service Bureau at (617) 887-MDOR.

### **If you are receiving a refund**

Your refund check will be mailed to you as soon as we have completed processing your return. If you have not received your check within 21 days from the date you filed, please contact the MDOR Customer Service Bureau at (617) 887-MDOR.

### **If you owe a balance**

If your electronically filed return showed a balance due, you must pay the amount you owe on or before April 15, 2010. If your payment is not received by April 15, 2010, you will be sent a Notice of Assessment (NOA). This notice will show your tax due, plus any interest and penalty assessments for late payment.
