1	<p>Learning Walkthroughs 101: This one-hour training provides a high-level overview of the <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> process, highlighting key features, benefits of the process, and the theories on which it is based.</p> <p>The overview is targeted to a wide range of stakeholders who would benefit from a basic understanding of the process, including district staff, school faculty, students, families, community partners, and other stakeholders. 2	<p>Learning Walkthroughs 201: This four-hour training provides a comprehensive introduction to the <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> process, providing participants with the initial knowledge needed to conduct <i>Learning Walkthroughs</i> in their school or district. This training introduces the theories that ground the process, discusses important management processes (for example, how to select a <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> team), and provides instruction on and guided practice with key <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> tools and processes.</p> <p>The comprehensive training is designed for <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> facilitators and individuals who will be serving on <i>Learning Walkthrough</i> visiting teams.
