Application for Massachusetts Division of Fisheries & Wildlife (MDFW) Trap Registration Certificate

In order to be issued a Massachusetts Division of Fisheries & Wildlife trap registration certificate or certificate of partnership, or trap on land of another, a person must complete a Trapper Education course from any US state and be issued a certificate of completion of such training.

A Massachusetts Trap registration Certificate is valid for two years and must be renewed biannually.

Pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 131, § 80 of the Massachusetts General Laws, I hereby apply for:

- A. **an initial MDFW Trap registration certificate.** I am a graduate of a Trapper Education course and a copy of my Trapper Education certificate is enclosed. (A state issued certificate from any US state is accepted). Once you obtain your registration number, be sure to register and tag all traps.
- i. Traps in your possession and use must have your assigned registration number embedded or cut not less than one eighth of an inch high into the trap.
 - ii. All Traps must also have a metal tag attached bearing the owner's name, town, and registration number
- B. **a renewal certificate of my MDFW Trap Registration No:** _____
