### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESOURCES ("MDAR") HEREBY GIVES NOTICE OF A GENERAL HEARING, PURSUANT TO M.G.L. C.30A, § 2 and 950 CMR 20.04, which requires the Commissioner of the Department of Agricultural Resources to hold a public hearing to amend the following regulations: 330 CMR 3.00: Shipment of Dogs Into The Commonwealth; 330 CMR 4.00: Cattle; 330 CMR 5.00: Poultry; 330 CMR 6.00: Seeds, Apples And Potatoes; 330 CMR 11.00: Swine; 330 CMR 16.00: Horses; 330 CMR 21.00: Supervision of Milk Pricing And Supply; 330 CMR 27.00: Standards and Sanitation Requirements for Raw Milk; 330 CMR 28.00: Milk And Milk Products ("Regulations").

The above listed Regulations are being amended solely for the purpose of making typographical corrections and updating the name of the agency and bureau or division that may be listed in order to conform to the current organization of the agency. The name of the agency was changed from the Department of Food and Agriculture to the Department of Agricultural Resources by Chapter 41 of the Acts of 2003. No other changes are proposed.

All persons desiring to provide oral testimony are hereby notified to appear on the following date and time at the respective designated location:
