MassDOT's Farmer's Market Program Begins

The Massachusetts Department of Transportation's Farmer's Market Program will begin on Friday, May 21, 2010, and invites local Massachusetts farmers to take advantage of free space at our 18 Service Plazas along various Massachusetts highways to sell their home-grown produce and made-in-Massachusetts products.

Complimentary vending space is made available on a first-come, first-served basis at the following locations: (Please note that 7 new service area locations are available this year) I-90 (Mass Turnpike) located in Lee, Blandford, Ludlow, Charlton, Westborough, Framingham and Natick. Rte. 128/I-95 locations in Newton, Lexington and Beverly. Rte. 24 locations in Bridgewater (north & southbound). Plymouth (Rte.3), and Barnstable (Rte. 6). Farmers can sell their goods as long as they do not compete with the businesses that operate within the service plazas.
