For more information visit [MassParks](#). Most programs are free, but [parking fees](#) may apply. Parking is free for Parks Pass holders, vehicles with handicapped, disabled veteran plates/placard, and seniors 62 and older with the Massachusetts Senior Pass.

Programs are subject to change, so call the park for cancellation information. Most programs are rain or shine, but pouring rain will cancel. Physical accommodations are available upon request. Dogs may be allowed on leash in some parks, but visitors should check with the park in advance.
