## TWO WEEK LOOK-AHEAD

August 16, 2014 – August 29, 2014

The following are activities you can expect to see over the next two weeks for the Waterfront Riverfront Park and Braille Trail Project:

- Install riverstone and fiber mulch in the sensory garden
- Install concrete footings for the 11 sensory benches and picnic tables
- Begin the Saltonstall Monument entrance construction
- Complete grading of the Irving Street entrance
- Complete work on the riverbank access areas
- Begin installation of the granite walls, stepping stones, and viewing deck along the riverbank and the pathway.

Construction Work Schedule: Monday-Thursday, 7AM to 6:00PM.

Public Access: The secondary path along the Charles River is closed for the duration of The construction project.
