The following activities will be occurring over the next two weeks.

Construction activities are wrapping up as the winter weather arrives.

Winthrop Beach Seawall

- Complete wall patching and concrete repairs (see photo at right)
- New boards for beach openings in the seawall

Saugus

- Work is completed for the year
- Slopes and erosion control devices will be monitored through the winter

Design for Phase 4 - Winthrop Shore Drive

Improvements

- Design drawings and specifications for Phase 4 of the Winthrop Beach Improvements are being advanced to allow for the bidding of this work in early 2016.
- Improvements include:
 - New and wider sidewalks
 - Repaved roadway
 - New stormwater system
 - Amenities (showers, drinking fountains, benches, bike racks) at entrances at Coral Ave., Cutler Av., Sturgis St. and Charles St.)
 - New stairs near Locust Street
 - Repairing concrete stairs and railings by the Highlands



Deteriorated concrete was removed and new concrete will be installed in this section of the seawall near Myrtle Ave.
