DRAFT RENEWAL OPERATING PERMIT

Dear Mr. Engel:

The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") has determined that the Operating Permit application for the FLEXcon Company, Inc. 1 FLEXcon Industrial Park, in Spencer, MA is administratively and technically complete and hereby issues the enclosed Draft Operating Permit for the subject facility.

This Draft Renewal Operating Permit is being issued in accordance with 310 CMR 7.00 - APPENDIX C of the Air Pollution Control Regulations ("the Regulations"), as adopted pursuant to M.G.L. c. 111, §§ 142 A through E inclusive.

FLEXcon is a major source of Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP). This draft operating permit contains the requirements for four existing emergency generators referred to as emission units 1-4 (EU1-4) as they apply to 40 CFR 63 subpart ZZZZ, and to a new generator EU5 as it applies to 40 CFR 60 subpart JJJJ and 310 CMR 7.26(42). This renewal contains the requirements for emission units B1 and B2 because they are subject to 40 CFR 63 subpart DDDDD.

Compliance assurance monitoring (CAM) does not apply to this facility because it is subject to more stringent emission limits established in National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) and New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) proposed after November 15, 1990.

Public notice of this Draft Renewal Operating Permit will be published by the Department in accordance with the requirements of 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C in the Telegram and Gazette by July 22, 2015. As such, the public comment period shall end on September 8, 2015. During that period, a public hearing may be requested pursuant to 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C(6)(f). You shall be notified under a separate letter if a public hearing has been requested.

Please review the entire Draft Operating Permit carefully. It lists the applicable Federal and State Air Pollution Control Requirements and what is required of the facility in order for it to be considered in compliance with such applicable requirements. It also includes requirements that were promulgated or approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency through rule making at the time of issuance but have future effective compliance dates.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Environmental Protection, acting in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. chapter 111, Section 142A through 142E, will offer for public comment the following draft Operating Permit issued pursuant to 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C.

The draft RENEWAL Operating Permit for FLEXcon Company, Inc. is being issued in accordance with 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C(6). The Operating Permit Renewal includes 40 CFR 63 subpart ZZZZ requirements for existing engines at a major source of Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP), 40 CFR 63 subpart DDDDD for Industrial, commercial boilers at a major source of HAP and 40 CFR 60 subpart JJJJ for spark ignition engines. The purpose of the Operating Permit is to codify all of the facility's applicable requirements under the state and federal Clean Air Act, including monitoring, record keeping requirements and emission limitations, into a renewable Operating Permit. This action is required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as stated in its final rule approving the Department's Operating Permit program (Federal Register Vol. 61, No. 95 Wednesday May 15, 1996).

The public comment period will extend until September 8, 2015. Under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30A and 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C(6)(f), a public hearing may be requested by any person by submitting a written request to the Regional Office, stating the nature of the issues to be raised at a public hearing. Based on the written request, the Department will determine if a public hearing will be held and a 30 day written notice will be given. The duration of the public comment period shall automatically extend to the close of the public hearing as provided for at 310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C(6)(g).

Comments may be presented in writing until 5:00 PM on September 8, 2015. Please submit three copies of any written testimony. Written testimony shall be submitted to:
