Vehicle Repower Program

Application Instructions: Deadline is 5:00 p.m. on April 30, 2014

The application form consists of two pages:

- Page 1: Sections A, B, and C1, request general information of the applicant and the existing vehicle and engine.
- Page 2: Section C2. requests information regarding the repowered engine as well as part and installation costs. Section D requires the authorized applicant to sign and date the certification statement.

The Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) highly recommends that Sections C.1 and C.2 be completed jointly by the applicant and the MassDEP-approved technology vendor (MiltonCAT).

MassDEP requires specific information for the vehicle, including the vehicle identification number (VIN), vehicle license plate/registration number, the vehicle model year, make (manufacturer), and model, the vehicle's U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) engine family number, the engine model year, make (manufacturer) and model, the engine horsepower rating and the vehicle's gross vehicle weight. MassDEP also requires information on the average annual number of hours the vehicle has operated for the past two years. Much of this information can be found on the vehicle tag located on the driver side door and the engine mounted identification plaque or tag.

Eligible Caterpillar Wheeled Loader Models

The engines for this program are purpose built by Caterpillar to replace unregulated Tier 0 engines with Tier 1 engines. All engines offered in this program meet the output limits of Tier 1 engines and replace the original Tier 0 engines. Current eligible Caterpillar wheeled loader models are listed in the table below.
