Chapter 111, Sections 142A through 142M, and in conformance with the requirements of 310 CMR 7.38(5), will hold a public hearing on the Renewal Application for the Central Artery/Tunnel Project Operating Certification (Certification) pursuant to *Certification of Tunnel Ventilation Systems in the Metropolitan Boston Air Pollution Control District, 310 CMR 7.38*. The certification was submitted by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) on September 12, 2016.
