MassDEP Public Meeting: Kids vs. Global Warming Petition

Dear MassDEP GHG Stakeholder:

MassDEP will hold a public meeting in response to a petition titled “Petition For Promulgation of a Rule to Strictly Limit and Regulate Greenhouse Gas Emissions and to Establish an Effective Annual Emissions Reduction Strategy That Will Achieve Massachusetts’ Statutory Obligation.” The petition was submitted in November 2012 by Kids vs. Global Warming and a group of students that attend Boston public schools and Boston College Law School. At the meeting, MassDEP will allow time for the petitioners to present information about the petition, and may also provide relevant information about actions that MassDEP is taking to address global warming and/or, as time allows, offer the opportunity for comment by interested parties.
