

Certification for Transfer Station Waste Ban Compliance Plans Pursuant to 310 CMR 19.035

Important: When completing this form on a computer, use only the Tab key to move your cursor – not the Return key.



The purpose of this form is for the facility's Responsible Official* to certify that the facility's waste ban compliance plan has been revised to comply with all waste bans regulations (see 310 CMR 19.017) and is consistent with the waste ban compliance plan guidance document.

Important Note: As a result of revisions to 310 CMR 19.000: Solid Waste Management Facility Regulations, effective February 14, 2014, any change to the design, construction, operation or maintenance of a solid waste transfer station that is not a C&D transfer station, must be submitted in accordance with a certification pursuant to 310 CMR 19.035. 310 CMR 19.035(2)(c) requires that this form be completed, signed and submitted to MassDEP to certify that the transfer station's waste ban plan is revised; the revised waste ban plan is not submitted to MassDEP with this form. The submission of this form is considered to satisfy the requirement of 310 CMR 19.017(6) for submitting the transfer station's revised waste ban plan. Therefore, the transfer station is still required to submit a complete Transfer Station Certification for all transfer station operations prior to February 15, 2015, to satisfy requirements pursuant to 310 CMR 19.035(2)(d) and (2)(f).
