FINAL DECISION

I have reviewed the attached Administrative Consent Order with Penalty – Acceptance of Settlement signed by Joseph Analetto for the petitioner on May 1, 2013, and by Geri Lambert for the Department on May 22, 2013 (ACOP-BO-13-ZS-Z004-SETT).

The petitioner is ordered to pay a civil administrative penalty in the amount of two hundred sixty dollars (\$260.00) in accordance with the schedule and terms of paragraphs 1 and 3 of the Administrative Consent Order with Penalty. Payment is due within thirty days of the date of this Final Decision.

The Department issues this Final Decision incorporating the Administrative Consent Order with Penalty. Under the terms of 310 CMR 1.01(8)(c), this proceeding is dismissed with the parties waiving whatever rights they may have to further administrative review before the Department as well as any appeal to court.

1. The Company agrees to pay \$260 as a civil administrative penalty in accordance with the terms of the above referenced MassDEP offer with payment due no later than 30 days from the issuance of the final decision approving this ACOP.
2. If this agreement is approved, the Company waives whatever rights they would otherwise have to further administrative review before MassDEP as well as an appeal to court, pursuant to 310 CMR 1.01(8)c.
3.
